### ***Caring for the Land, Preserving the Past***

Dr. Char Miller Ph.D

Char Miller is the W. M. Keck Professor of Environmental Analysis and History at Pomona College, in Claremont, California. His most recent books include *Theodore Roosevelt: Naturalist in the Arena* (2020), *Hetch Hetchy: A History in Documents* (2020), *The Nature of Hope: Grassroots Organizing, Environmental Justice, and Political Change* (2019), *Ogallala: Water for a Dry Land* (2018), *San Antonio: A Tricentennial History* (2018), and *Where There's Smoke: The Environmental Science, Public Policy, and Politics of Marijuana*. Other books include *Not So Golden State: Sustainability vs. the California Dream* (2016) and *America's Great National Forests, Wildernesses, and Grasslands* (2016). An award-winning teacher and writer, Miller is a Senior Fellow at the Pinchot Institute for Conservation, a Fellow of the Forest History Society and serves on the Board of Directors of the National Museum of Forest Service History.
